
Presidential Search Update

To: TAMCC Community Stakeholders

This will be the third update from the Presidential Selection Committee as we make our way through the search process.

Since our last communiqué, the Committee and our search consultants have been extremely busy. While I cannot share specific details due to our commitment to respecting the confidentiality of candidates, I can tell you that we are making solid headway.

The Committee reviewed the submissions of all the candidates to date and confirmed our plans for initial interviews. The first round of interviews took place 2-3 March via Skype, with St. George's University kindly allowing us to use one of their video conference rooms, and we spoke with candidates from the Caribbean, the United States, Canada and the Middle East.

The Committee members were very pleased with the quality of the candidates with whom we spoke – our consensus was that TAMCC's new President is in the mix of candidates we interviewed.

Our next step is to distill the candidate pool to a smaller number for in-person interviews and a campus visit which we anticipate will take place in late March or early April.

While we prepare for the on-island visit, our search partners are conversing with the candidates, checking references and ensuring our next meetings will be as fruitful as possible.

Once we have completed the next round of interviews, I will provide a further update to ensure you remain apprised of how our work is proceeding.

At this point the Committee is very encouraged by progress to date and by the quality of the candidates. Our members are working very well together and TAMCC continues to be effectively represented by its nominees – they are serving the College very well and we are grateful to them and all of our other Committee colleagues for permitting the search to encroach on their personal time.
